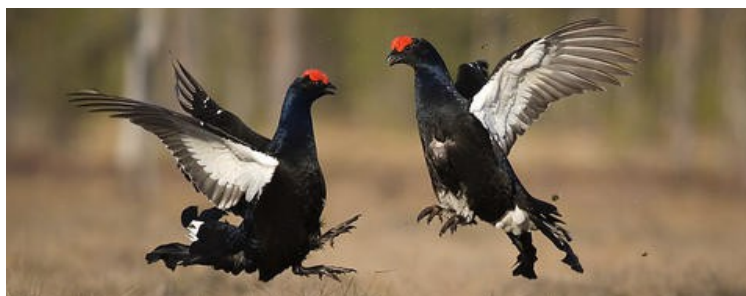

2.00pm. Shooting commences

The pool shoot is for practice and additional prizes will run throughout the event

All proceeds will be divided equally between The World Pheasant Association for research into Black Grouse conservation and Countryside Learning Scotland for its work in education about the Scottish countryside.
